### Artists Responsibilities

- Send early \$25 application fee to be paid to PIFMA, address below, or \$35 the day of the event.
- Register from 8:30 – 10:00am at Francis Marion Park at Front and Broad Street in Georgetown.
- Bring blank canvas(s)/painting surface(s) to registration.
- At registration, organizers will number canvas(s)/surfaces. Although we will number several canvases, you may enter only one of the numbered canvas(s) for judging at the “wet paint” reception and sale.
- At registration, we will provide a tag for the painting you want to be judged at the “Wet Paint” reception. Record the title, price, and medium and place it on the painting to be judged.
- Bring everything you need to paint and be comfortable while painting.
- Select location and paint en plein air.
- Artist sets up for “Wet Paint” sale between 3:30 and 3:45 in Francis Marion Park. Artist provides an easel to display “wet paint.”
- The painting, to be judged and available for sale, should be framed.
- The “Wet Paint” sale begins at 3:45pm and judging will begin at 4:00pm.
- Cash prizes will be awarded for first, second, and third places.
- The festival requests that you donate 20 percent of all sales to the Festival payable at the time of the sale. Space is limited but artist can bring select pieces or photos/catalogue of their work to sell.
- Artists are responsible for handling any sales during or after the event and/or any licensing requirements.

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
