- Artist will leave piece of art on Friday afternoon at the Cultural Council and will pick up on Saturday morning at 9:00 am.
- Bring completed piece to the artists' "Wet Paint" reception and sale on September 26th on the lawn of the **Kaminski House Museum** located at 1003 Front Street in Georgetown, SC, by 3:00 pm.
- Artists must provide easel(s) for each piece of art to participate in the "Wet Paint" sale.
- Provide title, price, and medium of "Wet Paint" placed on display at the reception.
- 20% of "Wet Paint" sales' proceeds will be donated to PIFMA's Visual Arts Program.
